Registration: JCA will accept registrations in the order we receive them and will confirm your registration in writing or by e-mail. If you wish to withdraw from a registered class and receive a full refund, JCA must receive your written notification at least two full weeks before the first class of the session for which you have registered. There are no refunds thereafter.
